



**Palate Notes:** This Pinot Noir is dark ruby in color. Raspberries, cherries, and dusty blueberries are beautifully layered in this wine with hints of Dr. Pepper and wet soil. There is a refined mouthfeel with solid acidity and velvety, silky tannins.

**Serving Suggestions:** Black cod with miso, filet mignon, pan fried sweet breads, Cojo salmon, and Colorado lamb.
